Ota City Community Cycle

Ota City Community Cycle is a bike share service that lets you rent a bike wherever you like and return it wherever you like. Bikes can be rented and returned at any share cycle port within ten cities of Tokyo. There are about 80 ports within Ota City. Use them to make your commuting, shopping, and sightseeing more convenient. (Membership registration is required.)

Information concerning Submission of Current Situation Notifications and Payment Months for the Child Allowance Program

Submission of current situation notification

A current situation notification must be submitted in order to receive the child allowance or special allowance for children 15 and under without interruption after June. Forms will be sent by post to those required to submit this notification in early June. Please submit this form by post by the end-of-June. Please note that the form will not be accepted at Ota City branch offices.

Scheduled deposit transfer date for June

The payment for the period between February and May 2020 will be deposited on June 9.

*The deposit may be delayed two or three days in the case of some financial institutions.

Child allowance (for person whose income is below the income limit)

Age category	Payment amount (monthly)
0 to under age 3 (flat rate)	15,000 yen/month
From age 3 until completion of elementary school education (1st and 2nd child)	10,000 yen/month
From age 3 until completion of elementary school education (3rd and later children)	15,000 yen/month
Junior high school student (up to first March 31st after 15th birthday) (flat rate)	10,000 yen/month

*Counting of the first child begins with a child being raised who is no older than 18 years old (up to the first March 31st after his/her 18th birthday).

Special Allowance (for person whose income meets or exceeds the income limit)

For Junior high school student and younger (flat rate): 5,000 yen/month

Ota City's Educational Consultation Office

- The office offers consultation (in person or by telephone) concerning your child's education, personality or behavioral concerns, and developmental disorders.
- It will also provide advice (in person or by telephone) concerning worries in your child's daily life, such as bullying or relationships with friends, as well as anxieties regarding his or her study or academic course.
- The office will make home visits as your child's situation requires, provide information on welfare services and the like, and coordinate with concerned organizations.

Eligibility

- Children living in Ota City who are still enrolled in compulsory education and their parents/guardians
- Children who wish to attend the adaptation guidance class "Tsubasa"

How to request consultation

- Please call the office in advance and reserve a day to visit.
- Requests for telephone consultations are accepted at any time.
 * If you cannot speak Japanese, please ask someone who can to help you with the call. If you will need an interpreter, please notify the office in advance.

Special warnings: Heavy rain, windstorm, snowstorm, heavy snow, waves, high tide (storm surge)

Earthquake information

Notices when an earthquake with a seismic intensity of 3 or higher occurs in Ota City

Notices when tsunami warnings or major tsunami warnings are announced in the Tokyo Bay area

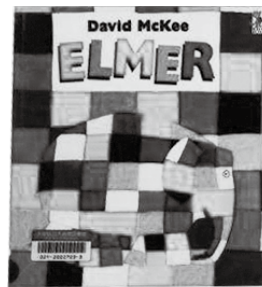

Recommended Books for Foreigners

Omori-Minami Library’s collection includes “Nihongo Tadoku Books,” a series of books for Japanese study prepared under the supervisory editorship of NPO Tadoku Supporters. They are written in simple Japanese at different difficulty levels and come with recorded text readings. They are recommended for anyone learning Japanese.

Omori-Minami Library also has a particularly large collection of books in Chinese and Korean, and new books were added in April.

Voice translation devices called POCKETALK are available at Omori-Minami Library. They help even visitors who have difficulty understanding or speaking Japanese use the library.
