· Furusato-no-Hamabe Area


This area will be bustling with stage events and international exchange under the theme of multiculturalism.



















[In-Person (Appointment Required) and Telephone Consultation with a Childcare Service Advisor]


[Application for Enrollment in Ota City Elementary and Junior High Schools for Children of Foreign Nationality]

If you have a child of foreign nationality who wishes to enter an Ota City elementary or junior high school in April 2024, you must apply for his or her enrollment. Ota City will send an enrollment guide to the households of eligible children in early October.

Eligibility:

Children born between April 2, 2017, and April 1, 2018 (for entry into elementary school)
Children born between April 2, 2011, and April 1, 2012, who are expected to graduate from an Ota City elementary school (for entry into junior high school)

Applications must be received by October 23, 2023.



Ota City's Loan-Type/Benefit-Type Scholarship Program for **Students Going on to Higher Education**

Ota City offers a "loan-type/benefit-type scholarship" program for people planning to enter a university or similar institution who meet certain criteria.

* Please inquire about requirements and selection criteria.



Benefit-type: 150,000 yen (lump-sum payment made before entering university, etc.)

> Loan-type: National or public institution: Maximum of 35,000 per month

Private institution: Maximum of 44,000 per month

Benefit-type: 50 Loan-type: To be announced when decided


("Ota Residents' Week" at Tokyo Mega Illumination)



- (2) School-age child (from 6 to 15 years old) who has not yet enrolled in school.
- (3) Child who lacks Japanese skills and is not enrolled in an Ota City school.
